

Configuring the Events Buttons

Here is the Events Config Page where you can select and deselect the items that matter to you. There are two images below. One shows the selections and one shows the results of those selections.



Those buttons come already loaded, but you can chose which ones to show and which ones to hide

The second tab of the Events section lets you add lots of other buttons if they will help you record the events of your roast.



Here is what your Labels look like in the Events page:
